WHAT WILL I DO?

As a Counselor, your purpose is to assist people with the treatment and diagnosis of mental health. You'll need to be good at problem solving and be comfortable talking in front of people, as you'll spend your days consoling patients. Problem-solving skills are also a must as you help people navigate difficult times in their lives and troubles they may be having.

Radiology is used to detect and treat illness in patients all across the country, and as a Radiologic Technologist, you'll be in charge of aiding doctors by using a magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) and computed tomography (CT) scanner. Doctors rely on you to interpret the images created and collect information regarding patients' medical states.

Dietitians don't help you lose weight for your cousin's daughter's wedding in May, they help you create and maintain healthy eating habits that change your lifestyle and reduce disease. Using food and nutritional facts, you will shape patients' diets to their needs, allergies, and general capabilities to ensure they're as healthy as they can be.

Ecologists study potential and current threats to specific ecosystems. In this role, you will work to prevent as many threats as you can by analyzing the ins and outs of the ecosystem. You'll know its characteristics and the creatures that inhabit it, all while working to protect them and their way of life. Proposing ways to maintain stability and decrease threats will be two of your favorite things.

Nurses play key roles in the health industry as the frontline of hospitals and medical centers. They work directly with patients, recording vitals and reviewing treatments. As a Registered Nurse, you make connections with patients that stem from genuine care and offer guidance in accordance with what you think is best.

As a Dental Hygienist, you get to see all kinds of people and their teeth. From wrangling a squirming 8-year-old to calming down a sweet old grandpa, you see every kind of tooth the world has to offer. Taking X-rays, giving patients dental advice, and cleaning teeth are your forte. Don't forget to floss!

Everyone needs a doctor - that's just the truth. And while you won't be everyone's doctor per se, you will be seeing all sorts of illnesses that the general public catches. As a Doctor, you will be tasked with observing, taking note of, and diagnosing patients in addition to offering prescriptions for cures. Whether you work in a large hospital or a private clinic people will seek you out to solve even the smallest of colds.
